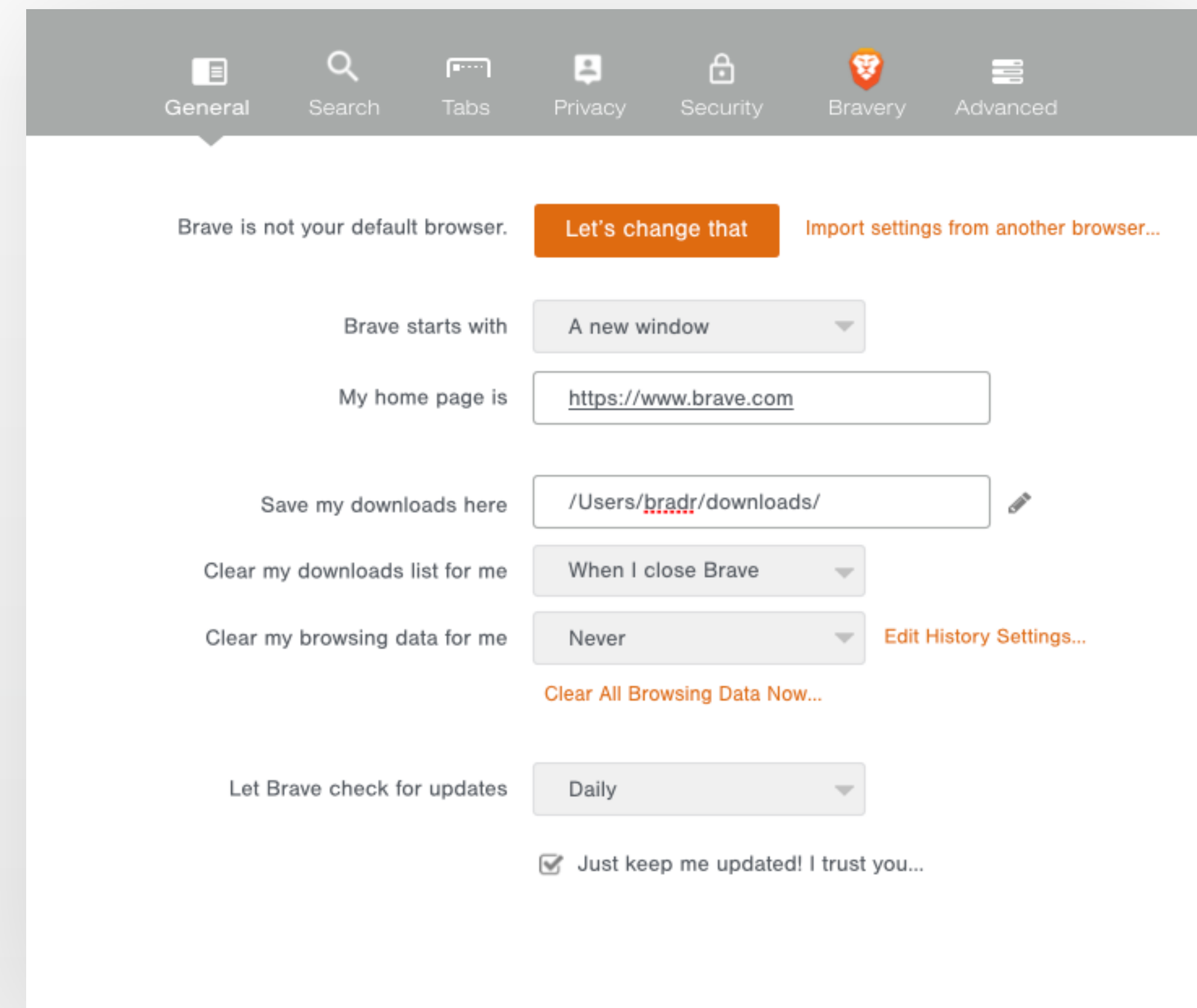

This design specification shows screen mocks for the Brave-Laptop prefs panels. More detail will be added as time permits, or feedback drives changes.

These panels will be accessed through the normal App menu for each OS, and will be shared between Mac, Windows and Linux.

They will be displayed in a new tab, directly to the right of the currently selected tab.

These panels will be implemented gradually as plumbing is put in place and can be connected with these settings. Some features shown here may not be available until 1.0 Stable releases.

Helpful hints...

Search is a powerful thing. So we added a few powerful features for you. Any time you want to search your favorite engine, just start typing in the URL bar. Your default engine will be used, and the rest will be "At the ready" with a single click.

But wait, there's much more. Now you can use slash-keys. Simply type "/G" before your search string and Brave will send it to Google regardless of your current default engine.

Still not enough? Go ahead, type TWO in a row, and we will open 2 tabs with results from two different engines.

Tab sets provide a new way to get organized, stay organized, or just collect tabs in a more manageable way.

Use the tab set indicator to jump quickly through tabs, and see which tab is making noise.

Brave protects you from trackers on the web and recommends that you keep this setting enabled at all times unless there is a problem which should be addressed on a site-specific basis.

Brave does not believe DNT is effective but we provide it in case it's needed for testing or specific use cases.
